

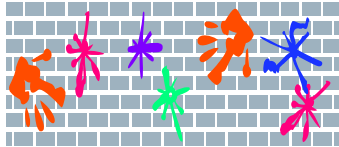

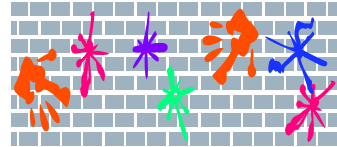

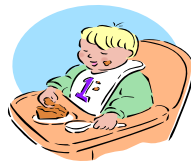


We will be working on putting on our coats, hats, gloves, and boots, so we are able to spend more time outside in the snow.

Did you know that my teacher's are Miss Trina and Miss Pat? They have been helping me to strength my legs, pull myself up, and I'm trying to use a spoon.

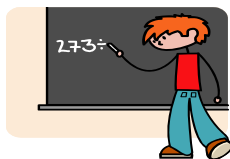


I do not always get the food into my mouth, but I am trying! Please send me another change of clothes. I am working on learning to put items inside a container, and dumping them back onto the floor.

Miss Tawny is our preschool teacher.

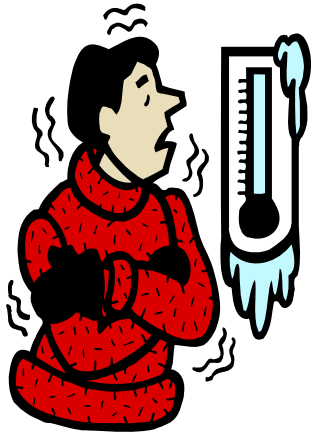
